Enhancements

115957- Recruitment: Consistent Warning When Changing Candidate Stages

Overview

Following customer feedback, we've improved the warnings shown when a candidate's stage is changed. The confirmation message is now clear and consistent across all Recruitment views, helping prevent accidental updates that might trigger workflows.

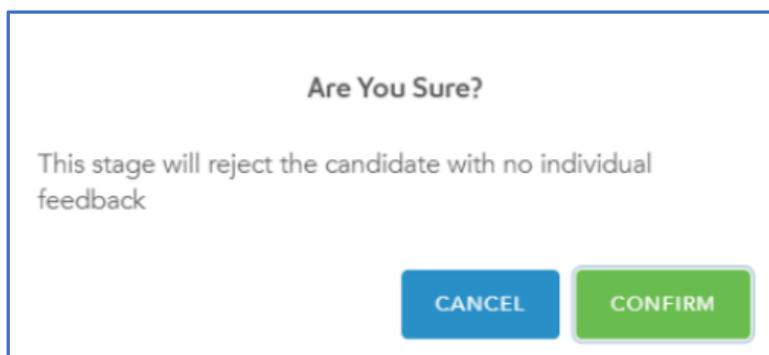
Benefits:

- Reduces accidental stage changes
- Prevents unintended workflow triggers
- Ensures consistency across all recruitment views
- Supports safer decision-making for hiring teams

How to Use

The improved confirmation popup appears automatically when editing stages within:

- Candidate Table View
- Candidate Card View
- Candidate Grid View Behaviour
- Confirm → Stage updates
- Cancel / clicking outside → No changes
- When selecting a rejection stage → A stronger warning explains the impact and lack of individual feedback

Fixes

144152 – Incorrect Mileage Rate Applied for Financial Year

Issue resolved where mileage calculations used calendar-year limits instead of financial-year limits, causing incorrect lower rates to be applied.

145561 – Apostrophe Display Issue in Social Recognition

Issue resolved where special characters such as (') displayed incorrectly with a slash (/) before them in recognition messages and emails.

145659 – Incorrect Display of Payment Codes in Timesheets

Issue resolved where payment codes beginning with zero (e.g., 032) displayed incorrectly after saving, despite storing correctly in the background.

146363 – Time Off Carryover Split Missing Start Date

Issue resolved where split time-off requests failed to assign a start date to the second record when using carryover, preventing managers from approving the request.

146369 – Custom Workflow Not Triggered for Split Time Off Requests

Issue resolved where split time off records did not both trigger the custom approval workflow when carryover was enabled, causing approval and audit log issues.
